Coburn Street Area Water & Sewer Improvements

PROJECT OVERVIEW

This project is integral to the overall upgrade of the Town’s water distribution and wastewater collection systems. It will upgrade the water and wastewater infrastructure located within the Coburn Street area, which has exceeded its design life. The roadway and pedestrian accommodations are also significantly deteriorated and require substantial reconstruction to improve access. The project will replace deteriorated underground utilities as part of the Town’s comprehensive infrastructure program. The sanitary gravity sewer and water main are being replaced at the same time to allow the DPW to provide a complete roadway restoration after utility upgrades are completed.

The project area includes Mellen Street, Saucier Street, Bridges Street, Hilton Street, Naples Street, and Coburn Street. The comprehensive upgrade of the utilities, roadways, and pedestrian access will provide long-lasting benefits to the area.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction will begin in late spring/early summer and continue into the fall of this year and will resume in the spring of 2012.

PROJECT STATISTICS

- 4,000 feet of new water main, hydrants and service connections
- 3,500 feet of new sewer main, sewer manholes and service connections
